In order to change these antisocial behaviors, resource parents will be given tangible tools and ideas on ways to help the adolescent's identify their thoughts (i.e. 'thinking reports'), and, in turn, change these thoughts to more pro-social thoughts. Once thoughts are identified and modified, behavior can be modified, allowing these youth to be more positive, productive members of their communities.

This training also focuses on the implementation of effective rewards/consequences for difficult youth. Foster parents will be given the necessary tools to be able to model appropriate behaviors for youth, allow the youth to practice these behaviors, and know how to properly reinforce these behaviors. Effective ways to work with the biological families of foster youth will also be examined, resource parents sharing what they have learned through this curriculum with them. This curriculum also focuses on working with the families of juvenile offender youth, resource parents acting as role models, teaching biological parents how to use the tools they have learned in this curriculum with their children.</p> <p data-bbox="754 1106 1693 1209">Notes: Please note that BOTH training sessions must be completed to receive your certificate of completion.
